CITY OF GRENADA CIVIL EMERGENCY – COVID-19 MEASURES PASSED AND ORDER BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND MAYOR ON 3-23-2020

BUSINESSES ALLOWED TO REMAIN OPEN WITH RESTRICTIONS

- 1. Social distancing will be enforced starting at noon on Tuesday, March 24, 2020.
- 2. Restaurants will remain open and may provide take-out, delivery and drive-thru pick-up. There shall not be more than 10 customers inside the business at any one time.
- 3. Churches and other assemblages and gatherings only permitted with 10 or fewer people.
- 4. All businesses employing 10 or more persons in one business location must follow Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Mississippi State Department of Health (MSDH) guidance and implement safeguards to prevent the spread.
- 5. Essential service businesses and agencies including hospitals, nursing homes, health clinics, drug stores, pharmacies, banks, grocery stores, convenience stores, gas stations, military installations, security and emergency response operations. These business must follow CDC and MSDH guidance and must implement safeguards to prevent spread to the extent that is practical.
- 6. The city recommends funeral services to be limited to 10 or less people. The city recommends holding funerals on the property of the funeral home. This recommendation follows the CDC and MSDH guidelines.
- 7. Liquor stores will allow no more than 10 customers inside a store at one time.
