

# **City of Grenada COVID-19 State, Community and Departmental Guidelines**

- Public gatherings of 10 or more people are prohibited. (Practice social distancing)
- Executive Order No. 1459 (Office of the Governor) activates the Mississippi National Guard to support mobile testing units and support the Mississippi State Department of Health and Mississippi Emergency Management Agency at the testing locations. (Please read the full order)
- Executive Order No. 1458 (Office of the Governor) allows state agencies to determine which state employees are essential and send everyone else home. He encouraged other businesses in Mississippi to do the same with their employees. The second executive order asks schools to continue providing free and reduced lunches to students as well. (Please read the full order)
- Governor Tate Reeves signed an executive order on Thursday, March 19, 2020 to close all Mississippi public schools through April 17, 2020 due to the coronavirus outbreak.
- Please review COVID-19 information previously posted on the City of Grenada's website ([www.cityofgrenada.net](http://www.cityofgrenada.net)) and the City of Grenada Facebook page.
- During this time, we ask that people adhere to the prevention tips outlined by the centers for disease control. We will continue to update the public on city related closures, postponements, and information. We are updating this information daily.
